

ANAGRAM

Indicators - *in a mess, mistakenly, engineered, at random ...*

EMBEDDED

Indicators - *In, held by, partially, contains, among, from ...*

SEQUENCE

Indicators - *Regularly, evenly, oddly, initially, finally, primarily ...*

HOMOPHONE

(SOUND ALIKE)

Indicators - *I heard, on the radio, it's said, pronounced, announced ...*

REVERSALS

Indicators - *in retreat, on reflection, northbound, to the left ...*

SUBTRACTIONS

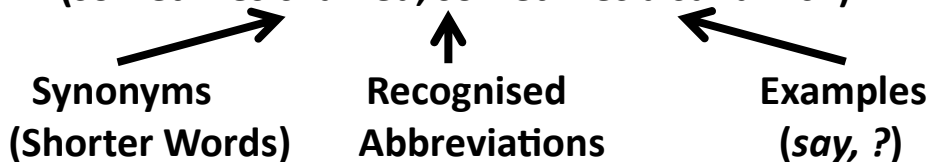
Indicators - *almost, cut short, minus, lacking, disheartened, limitless*

Or outputs from any of the above types of wordplay



CHARADE TYPE CLUES

assembled together from shorter components
(sometimes chained, sometimes a sandwich)



DOUBLE DEFINITIONS

No wordplay, just two halves each defining the same answer

SIMPLY CRYPTIC

Think laterally using whole clue as single riddle to get to the solution

Look for indicator words, to spot any clues of these types, especially to help give you a start in the grid

+ several clue types mixed into a single solution

+ odd clues with NO wordplay
